8: Guest Speaker

Robert Coulombe – Roy McMurtry Legal Clinic

Robert shared a presentation and spoke to the committee on rights under the Residential Tenancies Act which defines Tenant's rights and obligations. Some of the basic rights were explained.

- *Security of Tenure* - regarding justifiable reasons for eviction, and steps to take when an illegal eviction takes place.
- *Privacy* – how a landlord must give proper notice and valid reason before entering a rental unit.
- *Rent Deposits* – an outline of what a landlord can request as a deposit.
- *Rent Controls* – limitations on when and how much a rent can be increased was explained.
- *Housing and Human Rights* – regarding providing reasonable accommodations and rights against discrimination.
- *Repair and Maintenance* – a landlord's obligation to keep the rental unit in a good state of repair and maintenance was summarized.
- *Vital Services* – Cornwall's by-law regarding landlord's interrupting heat, electricity and water services was explained.

- *Co Tenants, Undertenants, Guests, Spouses* – definitions for each of these types of individuals and their responsibilities were given.
- *Victims of Violence* – a description was given on a tenant’s ability and process on breaking a co-tenancy when domestic violence and abuse is involved.

Several resources were provided for anyone wanting further information. Robert’s presentation was shared with all the members.

9. Information Sharing

- **York Centre:**
 - Operating hours have not changed.
 - They have partnered with the Happy Popcorn Company for the purchase of a Mystery Box to raise additional funds. The Mystery Boxes will be available for purchase until May 31, 2021.
- **Équipe psycho-sociale:**
 - Mothers in Mind is a 10 week/2 hours per week program beginning in September, which is a group for mothers who are trauma survivors that want to create and foster attachment bonds with their children under the age of 4.

 - Seniors on Wheels is a program which will see volunteers take seniors for a ride through the city’s waterfront bicycle trails which begins June 7, 2021. Rides can be booked on the City of Cornwall website.
